AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Services in respect of the months of April, May, June and July, 1999.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the fiftieth year of the Republic of India as follows:

Short title.

1) This act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1999.

2) From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of (Rupees Three hundred and four crores thirty seven lakhs and four thousand) only towards "Vote on Account" for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the months of April, May, June and July, 1999 in respect of services specified in Column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3) The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by the Act, shall be appropriated for the Services and purposed expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
