NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/5/94-P&AR(GSW), the 30th Mach, 1999. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso of Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Deputy Director of Horticulture/Training Associate (Horti) K.V.K/Divisional Horticulture Officer under Horticulture Department, Government of Mizoram namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.
- (i) These Rules may be called the Govt. of Mizoram Agriculture Department (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 1999.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publications in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.

These Rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto Annexed.

3. Number of posts, classification & scale of pay.

The number of the said posts, (s) their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 - 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. Method of Rectt., age limit and other qualification.

The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 - 14 of the Schedule aforesaid

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time. No person,

- 5. Disqualification.
- a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from operation of these Rules.

- 6. Training and:
 Departmental
 Examination.
- Every Govt. servant recruited under these Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
- 7. Power to : transfer

Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and powers to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

8. Power to relax.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Departmental Pronotion Committee/Mizoram Public Service Commission, as the case may be, through the Department of P&AR, relax any of the provisions to these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

9. Reservations and other concessions.

Nothing in this rules shall affect any reservations or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes/Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.

10. Repeal and Savings : All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Assam or Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' Notification No. 14/21/72-HMP dated 21.1. 1972 or framed by the Government of Mizoram prior to the commencement of these Rules stand hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
