## **EXTRA ORDINARY**

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#### **NOTIFICATION**

No.A.12018/5/94-P&AR(GSW), the 30th March, 1999. In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Sub-Divisional Horticulture Officer/Assistant Divisional Horticulture Officer under Horticulture Department, Govt. of Mizoram, namely :-

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| Short title and Commencement.                        | 1. (i) These Rules may be called the Govt. of Mizoram Agriculture Department (Horticulture Wing) (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1999.                   |
|  | (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.   |
| Application.   | 2. The Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column-I of the Schedule hereto annexed.   |
| Number of posts, classification & Scale of pay.      | 3. The number of the said post(s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2-4 of the Schedule aforesaid. |
| Method of Rectt., age limit and other qualification. | 4. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.             |

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

**Disqualification. 5. No person —**

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouses living; or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these Rules.

**Training and Departmental Examination.****Power to transfer.****Power to relax.****Reservation and other concessions.****Repeal and Savings.**

- 6. Every Government servant recruited under these Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
- 8. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Departmental Promotion Committee/MPSC, as the case may be, through the Department of Personnel & Admn. Reforms, relax any of the provisions to these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 9. Nothing in these Rules shall affect any reservation or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes,/ Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
- 10. All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Govt. of Assam or Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' Notification No.14/21/72-HMP dated 21.1.1972 or framed by the Govt. of Mizoram prior to the commencement of these Rules stand hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
