NOTIFICATION

No.H.14011/1/96-DCA/L-1: Whereas the Governor of Mizoram is satisfied from the fact of resignations of the elected Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Lai Autonomous District Council and refusal of the panel - chairpersons and other member specifically designated for the purpose to perform the duties of the Chairman, and on due consideration of other material facts and circumstances as reported, that a situation has arisen in which the administration of Lai Autonomous District Council cannot be carried on in accordance with the provisions of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India and the laws applicable;

And whereas it is considered expedient in public interest and in the interest of smooth functioning of the Lai Autonomous District Council to resolve the ongoing impasse by exercising his discretionery powers in consultation with the council of Ministers, under sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 16 read with paragraph 20BB of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-paragraph(2) of paragraph 16 read with paragraph 20BB of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram hereby assumes to himself all powers and functions vested in and exercisable by the Lai Autonomous District Council with immediate effect for a period not exceeding six months at the first instance.

Consequent to the assumption of powers and functions of the Lai Autonomous District Council by the Governor, the Chief Executive Member and other Executive Members of the said Council shall cease to hold office and to function as such during the aforesaid period.
