THE INCOME-TAX (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1999

NO. 7 OF 1999

Promulgated by the President in the Fiftieth Year of the Republic of India.

An Ordinance further to amend the Income-tax Act, 1961.

WHEREAS the House of the People has been dissolved and the Council of States is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Income Short title -tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1999.

 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment 2. In section 80G of the Income-tax Act, 1961, in sub-section (i), in clause (i), for the words, brackets, 80G of Act figures and letter "in sub-clause (iiia)", the words, 43 of 1961. brackets, figures and letter "in sub-clause (i) or in sub-clause (iiia) "shall be substituted with effect from the 1st day of April, 2000.
