### **THE APPROPRIATION (RAILWAYS) ACT, 1999**

#### **AN ACT**

*to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of India to meet the amounts spent on certain services for the purposes of Railways during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1997, in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.*

Enacted by Parliament in the Fiftieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Railways) Act, 1999.
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of India, the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one hundred and ninety-one crores, thirty-four lakhs, forty-eight thousand, five hundred and fifty-six rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services relating to Railways specified in column 2 of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1997, in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.
