## **NOTIFICATION**

No. J. 11013/2/98-LJE/57, the 30th August, 1999. Whereas it is expedient in the public interest to amend the Mizeram State Legal Services Authorities Rules, 1996 (herein after referred to as the principal Rules) as amended from time to time, the Governor of Mizoram, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (n) of sub-section (2) of section 28 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 (Act No. 39 of 1987) as amended from time to time, and in consultation with the Gauhati High Court, is pleased to make the following Rules, namely:

- Short title, extent 1. (1) These Rules shall be called the Mizoram State Legal Services Authorities (Second Amendment) Rules, 1999.
  - (2) They shall have the like extent as the principal Rules.
  - (3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official gazette.
- Amendment of Rule 16

2.

For Rule 16 of the principal Rules, the following rule shall be substituted, namely—

"Any citizen of India whose annual income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) only or such higher amount as may be notified by the State Government from time to time, sball be entitled to legal services under clause (h) of section 12 of the Act".
