## NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/3/89-P&AR(GSW), the 12th October, 1999. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Principal Scientific Officer under Science and Technology Cell, Planning Department, Government of Mizoram, as follows:

- 1. Short title and (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Science and Commencement. Technology Cell, under Planning Department (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 1999.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.

These Rules shall apply to the post, specified in Column 1 of the Annexure hereto annexed.

3. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of pay.

The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 - 4 of the Annexure aforesaid.

4. Method of recruit -The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the ment, age limit Annexure aforesaid. and other qualification.

> Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

- 5. Disqualification. No person -
  - (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

who, having a seouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal lew applicable to such person and to other party to the manninge and that there are other grounds for doing so, exampliany such person from the operation of these rules.

- 6. Training and Departmental Examination
- Every Government servant recruited under tress Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examinations as may be prescribed from time to time.
- 7. Power to transfer.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public laterest, sault have the right power to transfer any officed SO under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
- Power to relax.
- Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to recorded in writing in consultation with Departmental Promotion Committee/Mizaram Public Service Commission, as the case may be, through the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, relac any of the provisions to these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- other concessions.
- Reservations and Nothing in these Rules shall affect any reservations or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes. Scheduled Castes and other categories of parsons in accordance order issued by the Central Government or with the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.
- 10. Repeal and Savings.
- All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Assam or Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No.14/21/71-4134P dated 21.1.1972 or framed by the Government of Mizzaam prior to the commencement of these Rules stand hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any. action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
