The Objects of the Council shall be to promote and protect within the State the rights of the Consumer such as :-

- (a) The rights to be protected against the marketing of goods and services which are hazardous to life and property.
- (b) The right to be informed about the quality, quantity, potency, purity standard and price of goods or services so as to protect the Consumers against unfair trade practices.
- (c) the right to be assured whatever possible access to a variety of goods and services at competitive practices.
- (d) the right to be heard and to be assured that Consumers interest will receive due consideration at appropriates.
- (e) the right to seek redressal against unfair trade practices or restrictive trade practices or unscrupulous exploitation of Consumer Education
- (f) the right to Consumer Education.
