#### **NOTIFICATION**

No. G. 17012/5/93-F.

of the post of Engineering-in-Chief and the bifurcation of the then office of the Chief Engineer, PWD, into the Chief Engineer Zone-I and Chief Engineer Zone-II

and to delineate and specify the powers, functions and responsibilities of the Engineer-in-Chief and the 2 (two) Chief Engineers as follows :—

**1. PLANNING, APPROPRIATION AND RE-APPROPRIATION :**

tion and re-appropriation and the budgetary control including administration of loans and advances will be vested in the Engineer-in-Chief.

**2. TECHNICAL POWERS :**

The technical powers of the Engineer-in-Chief, and Chief Engineers shall be as per provisions of the CPWD Codes. Technical Powers shall, however not be constructed as Financial Power. The latter shall be governed by Rules and Notifications issued in this regards by the Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

**3. APPOINTMENT AND DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITY :**

Without prejudice to the powers vested in this regard with the DP&AR, the Engineer-in-Chief shall be appointing authority including promotion in respect of non-Gazetted Officers including Group-C and he shall exercise disciplinary authority under CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965. In case of Group-D and Work-Charge Staff appointing authority and Disciplinary authority will be the Chief Engineers within their Zones.

Common Seniority shall be maintained for all the regular technical and work charge staff of the Department by Engineer-in-Chief. Appointments/Promotions shall be made by Engineer-in-Chief/Chief Engineer on the recommendation of DPC chaired by the Engineer-in-Chief.

**4. TRANSFER AND POSTING**

Without prejudice to the powers vested in this regard with the DP&AR, the Engineer-in-Chief shall exercise the power of transfer and posting of all non-Gazetted staff, inter Zones. The Chief Engineer shall have the power in respect of Group-D and Work-charge staff and transfer and postings of non-Gazetted staff within their Zones.

**5. RELEASE/CONTROL OF LOC WITHIN THE APPROVED BUDGET**

The Engineer-in-Chief shall release the budget allocation to both the Chief-Engineers and the Chief Engineers in turn shall issue and control LOC within their Zones.

The Engineer-in-Chief shall function as Head of Department and shall have the power of supervisory control over the Chief engineer in monitoring of works and vigilance, planning and budgeting, appropriation and re-appropriation of fund. The Chief Engineer Zone-I and Chief Engineer Zone-II shall both function as Heads of Department within their respective Zones.

The Government of Mizoram shall reserve the powers of review and revision of the provisions contained in this Notification from time to time.
