NOTIFICATION

NoG.25022/1/91-PHE, the 29th February, 2000. In exercise of the powers conferred by clause-(1) of Section-14 of the Mizoram Water Tariff Act 1991, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following amendments of Mizoram Water Supply Tariff Rules 1993 and it will be effective from 1st March, 2000.

Clause-(b) of Rule-3 is ammended as

“All non-metered consumers shall have to pay a monthly flat rate of Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred) only per month.

All metered consumers shall however be charged based on the quantity of water supplied and as per provisions of Section 6 of Mizoram Water Tariff Act, 1991”.

Clause-(c) of Rule-3 is ammended as

“Any consumer in the list for drawing water from public water point or from hand pump tube well shall be charged at Rs. 10/- (Rupees ten) only per month unless such hand pump is proved out of order for a period of 30 days or more immediately preceeding the issue of such a bill for the purpose, and unless the Department has not supplied water to the public water point for a period not less than 10 days continously during the months immediately preceeding the issue of such water bills for the month.

• Clause-(e) is added in Rule 3 as

“Water Supply to any consumer, whose consumption of water are excessively high and not commensurate with the flat rate of Rs. 100/- per month as clasified below shall compulsorily be metered.

1. Hospitals
2. Hotels & Restaurants
3. Hotels
4. Jails
5. Assam Rifles Complex
6. Churches
7. All Government/Semi-Governments offices and Residential Quarters.

Decision of the Department in identifying and deciding those consumers shall be final and binding.
