The Mizoram Appropriation (No.1) Act, 2000 Act No. 1 of 2000.

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 28th March, 2000).

#### **AN ACT**

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the services of the Financial Year 1999-2000.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Fifty First Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

#### **Short title**

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No.1) Act, 2000

Issue of Rs.4,30,77,80,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Financial year 1999-2000

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rupees Four Hundred Thirty Crores Seventy Seven Lakhs and Eighty thousand only for defraying the several charges

which will come in course of payment during the Financial Year 1999-2000 in respect of the service specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

### Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
