NOTIFICATION

No. H. 12018/83/98-LJD/81, the 30th March, 2000: The following Act of Mizoram Legislative Assembly, which received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram is hereby published for General information.

The Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2000 Act No. 2 of 2000.

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 28th March, 2000)

AN ACT to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the services in respect of the month of April, 2000.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Fifty First Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title

Vote on Account for Rs.1,08,73,90,000 out of the consolidated Fund for the month of April, 2000.

- 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) (No. 2) Act, 2000.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rupees One Hundred Eight Crores Seventy Three Lakh and Ninety Thousand only towards "Vote on Account" for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the month of April, 2000 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
