NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/10/82-APT (B), the 5th May, 2000. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Graduate Hindi Teacher under the Department of Education and Human Resources Development Department namely :-

1. Short title and commencement. 1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Education and Human Resources Development (Group 'B' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2000.
2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. These Rules shall apply to the post (s) specified in column 1 of the Annexure hereto annexed.
3. No. of posts, Classification and scale of pay. The number of the said post (s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Annexure aforesaid.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the said Annexure.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification. No person—
 - a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

- b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Government of Mizoram may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these Rules.

6. Training and : Every Govt. servant recruited under these Rules shall under-
Departmental Examination. go such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. Power to : Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Go-
transfer. vernor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and power to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8. Power to : Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary
relax. or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Departmental Promotion Committee/Mizoram Public Service Commission, as the case may be, through the Department of P&AR, relax any of the provisions to these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
9. Reservation : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations or other con-
and other cessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/
concession. Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
10. Repeal and : All Rules pertaining to the recruitment to these posts (s)
Saving framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in force in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' Notification No.14/21-HMP(ii) dated 21.2.1972 and framed by the Government of Mizoram under Notification No.A.12018/10/82-APT(B) dt. 1.10.1996 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No.377 dt. 8.10.1996 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
