NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/21/80-APT (B)/Vol-I, the 15th May, 2000. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Pharmacist under Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Mizoram namely :—

1. Short title and commencement. 1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Health and Family Welfare Department (Group 'C' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2000.
2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. The Rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Annexure hereto annexed.
3. No. of posts, Classification and scale of pay. The number of the said post (s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Annexure aforesaid.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the Annexure aforesaid.
5. Disqualification. No person—
 - a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (s):

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these Rules.

6. Training and : Every Govt. servant recruited under these Rules shall under-
Departmental Examination. go such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. Power to : Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Go-
transfer. vernor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and powers to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8. Power to : Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary
relax. or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions to these Rules with respect to any class or categories of persons.
9. Reservation : Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservations or other
and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes,
concession. Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
10. Repeal and : All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Govern-
Savings ment of Assam or Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' Notification No. A. 14/21/71-HMP dated 21.1.1972 and framed by the Govt. of Mizoram vide Notification No. MFP. 174/73-75/21 dt. 3.4.75 and published in Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 12 dt. 25.4.75 in respect of Pharmacist are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
