NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/1/95-PAR(GSW)/Pt, the 18th July, 2000. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram hereby makes the following Rules to further amend the Mizoram Engineering Service Rules, 1995 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules) as notified vide Government of Mizoram's Notification PAR(GSW) dt. 11.10.95, and published in the Mizoram Gazette, Extra Ordinary issue No.461 dt. 20.11.1995, namely —

Short title and commencement. 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Engineering Service (Third Amendmend) Rules, 2000.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

Amendment of 2. In the principal Rules, for sub-rules (2) and (3) of Rule 4, sub-rules (2) and (3) of rule 4. the following sub-rules shall be substituted, namely —
“(2) The Mizoram Engineering Service shall consist of the following cadres, namely :—

(i) Public Works Cadre, which shall include the following separate wings —

(a) Civil Wing, which shall consist of the posts of Civil Engineers under the Public Works Department and the Power and Electricity Department ;

(b) Mechanical Wing, which shall consist of the posts of Mechanical Engineers under the Public Works Department ;

(c) Architectural Wing.

(ii) Power and Electricity Cadre, which shall include all the posts of Electrical or Electronic Engineers under the Power and Electricity Department, and the Public Works Department, and Mechanical Engineers under the Power and Electricity Department.

3. All Civil Engineers under Public Works Department and Power and Electricity Department and all Mechanical Engineers under the Public Works Department recruited prior to the commencement of these Rules shall stand allocated to the Public Works Cadre from the date of commencement of these rules or from such date or dates as may be notified by the Government. Similarly, all Electrical Engineers or Electronic Engineers under Power and Electricity Department and Public Works Department, and also Mechanical Engineers under the Power and Electricity Department recruited prior to the commencement of these Rules shall stand allocated to the Power and Electricity Cadre from the date of commencement of these Rules or from such date or dates as may be notified by the Government".
