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NOTIFICATION

No. B. 16021/35/90-IND, the 8th August, 2000. In exercise of the Powers under clause (n) of sub-section(2) of section 39 of the Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Act, 1982 as amended from time to time, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

Short title, 1(1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Khadi and Village extent and Industries Units (Registration) Rules, 2000.

Commencement

- (2) They shall extend to the whole of the State of Mizoram.
- (3) They shall come into force on such date as, the State Government may, by notification in the official gazette, appoint and different dates may be appointed for different areas.

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Definitions 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) "Act" means the Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Act, 1982 as amended;
- (b) "Board" means the Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board;
- (c) "Khadi" means any cloth woven on handloom in India, from cotton, silk or woolen yarn handspun in India or from a mixture of any two of such yarn. It shall also include traditional clothes woven on loinlooms;
- (d) "Rural Areas" means any area outside the limit of municipal area and areas within the jurisdiction of a village council in places where there are no proper municipal administration;

(e) "Village Industries" means any industry located in rural area, which produces goods or render any services with or without the use of power and in which fixed capital investment per head of an artisan or a worker does not exceed fifty thousand rupees.

Aims and Objects

3. The main aims and objects of these rules is to ensure healthy growth of industries and to regulate and control certain industries which are hazardous and dangerous to public health and safety.

Classification of Industries

- 4. For the purpose of these rules, Industries under the purview of Khadi and Village Industries may be classified as follows:—
- (1) GROUP 1: MINERAL BASED INDUSTRY;
- (a) Cottage Pottery Industry;
- (b) Limestone, Lime shell and other lime products industry;
- (c) Stone cutting, crushing, carving and engraving for Temples and buildings;
- (d) Utility article made out of stone;
- (e) Slate and slate pencil making;
- (f) Manufacture of plaster of paris;
- (g) Utensil washing powder;
- (h) Fuel briqueting;
- (i) Jewellery out of Gold, Silver Stone, Shell and synthetic materials;
- (i) Manufacture of Gulal, Rangoli;
- (k) Manufacture of Bangles;
- (i) Manufacture of paints, pigments, varaishes and Distempers;
- (m) Manufacture of Glass Toys:
- (n) Glass Decoration-cutting, designing and polishing;
- (o) Gem cutting.
- (2) GROUP II FOREST BASED INDUSTRY:
- (a) Handmade Paper;
- (b) Manufacture of Katha;

- (c) Manufacture of Gums and Resins;
- (d) Manufacture of Shellac;
- (e) Cottage Match Industry, Manufacture of fire Works and Agarbattis;
- f) Bamboo and Cane work;
- (g) Manufacture of paper cups, plates bags and other paper containers;
- (h) Manufacture of Exercise book binding, envelope making, register making, including all other stationery items made out of paper;
- (i) Khus tattis and broom making;
- (j) Collection, processing and packing of forest products;
- (k) Photo framing;
- (1) Manufacture of Jute products(under fibre industry).
- (3) GROUP III AGRO-BASED AND FOOD INDUSTRY:
- (a) Processing, packing and marketting of cereals, pulses, spices, condiments, masala etc.
- (b) Noodles making;
- (c) Power atta chakki;
- (d) Dalyia making;
- (e) Mini rice shelling unit;
- (f) Palmgur making and other palm products industry;
- (g) Manufacture of Cane Gur and Khansari.
- (h) Indian sweets making;
- (i) Raswanti-sugarcane juice catering unit;
- (j) Bee-keeping;
- (k) Fruits and vegetables processing, preservation and canning, including pickles;

(1) Ghani Oil Industry;

- (m) Menthol Oil;
- (n) Fibre other than coir;
- (o) Collection of forest plants and fruits for medicinal purpose;
- (p) Processing of maize and ragi;
- (q) Pith work, manufacture of pith mats and garlands etc;
- (r) Cashew processing;
- (s) Leaf cup making;
- (t) Milk products making unit;
- (u) Cattle feed, poultry feed making.
- (4) GROUP IV-POLYMER AND CHEMICAL BASED INDUSTRY:
- (a) Flaying, curing and tanning of hides and skins and ancillary industries connected with the same and cottage leather industry;
- (b) Cottage soap industry;
 - (c) Manufacture of Rubber goods(dipped latex products);
 - (d) Products out of Rexin PVC etc;
 - (e) Hornne and Bone including Ivory products;
 - (f) Candle, Camphor and sealing wax making;
 - (g) Manufacture of packing items of plastics;
 - (h) Manufacture of Bindi;
 - (i) Manufacture of Mehendi;
 - (j) Manufacture of essential oils;
 - (k) Manufacture of shampoos:
 - (I) Manufacture of Hair oils;
 - (m) Detergent and washing powder making(non-toxic);
 - (5) GROUP V ENGINEERING AND NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY.
 - (a) Carpentry;

- (b) Blacks mithy;
- (c) Manufacture of Household alluminium utensils;
- (d) Manufacture and use of manure and methane(Gobar)
 Gas from Cow dung and other waste products (such as flesh of dead animals, night soils etc.);
- (e) Vermiculture and waste disposal;
- (f) Manufacture of paper pins, clips, safety pins, stove pins etc.
- (g) Manufacture of decorative bulbs, bottles, glass etc.
- (h) Umbrella assembling;
- (i) Solar and wind energy implements;
- (j) Manufacture of handmade utensils out of brass;
- (k) Manufacture of handmade utensils out of copper;
- (1) Manufacture of handmade utensils out of bell metal;
- (m) Other articles made out of brass, copper, and bell metal;
- (n) Production of Radios;
- (o) Production of cassette player whether or not fitted with radio;
- (p) Production of cassette recorder whether or not fitted with radio;
- (q) Production of voltage stabilizer;
- (r) Manufacture of electronic clocks and alarm time pieces;
- (s) Carved wood and artistic furniture making;
- (t) Tinsmithy;
- (u) Motor winding;
- (v) Wire net making;
- (w) Iron grill making;
- (x) Manufacture of rural transport vehicles, such as hand care, bullock carts, small boats, assembly of bicycles, cycle rickshaw, motorised carts etc.
- (y) Manufacture of musical instruments;

- (6) GROUP VI TEXTILE INDUSTRY (EXCLUDING KHADI):
- (a) Polyvastra which means any cloth woven on handloom in India from yarn hanspun in India from a mixture of man made fibre with either cotton, silk or wool or with any two or all of man made fibre yarn hanspun in India with any two or all of such yarn;
- (b) Manufacture of Lok Vastra cloth;
- (c) Hosiery;
 - (d) Tailoring and preparation of readymade garments;
 - (e) Batick works;
 - (f) Toys and Doll making;
 - (g) Thread bulls and woolen balling, lacchi making;
 - (h) Embroidery;
 - (i) Manufacture of surgical bandages;
 - (i) Stove wicks
 - (k) Embroidery of fabrics;
 - (7) GROUP VII SERVICE INDUSTRY:
- Silver diese (a) (Laundry;
 - (b) Barber;
 - (c) Plumbing;
 - (d) Servicing of electric wiring and electronic appliances and equipments;
 - (e) Repairs of diesel engines, pumpsets etc.
 - (f) Tyre vulcanising unit;
 - (g) Agriculture servicing for sprayers, insecticide, pumpsets etc.

- (h) Hiring of sound system like loud speaker, amplifier, mike etc.
- (i) Battery charging;
- (j) Art Board painting;

The Control of

- (k) Cycle repair shops;
- (1) Masonry;
- (m) Band troupe;
- (n) Motorised local boat(fibre glass);
- (o) Motorcycle to ply as Taxi;
- (p) Musical instruments;
- (q) Dhabas (not serving liquor);
- (r) Tea stall;
- (s) Iodised salt.
- (8) Miscellaneous:— Any industries notified by Khadi and Village Industries Commission as village industries from time to time.

Polluting Industries

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- 5. (1) Industries that can cause social hazard such as smoke emitting industries, dirty waste, high-pitch sound, stench and other bad-smell or cause air pollution in different ways, shall be carefully located in an isolated place which is not frequented by the public.
- (2) The location of such polluting industries shall be carefully examined, before registration is granted. The Board shall notify such polluting industries from time to time.
- (3) The State Government shall consider alloting site for such industries on lease-basis.

Industrial Licencing

. Projection

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- 6. (1) The following industries shall produce licence from the competent authority of the State Government or Central Government, before they are given registration.
- a) Gun and weaponry industries;
- b) Fruit juice and canning industries;
- c) Chemical, fertilizers and toxic industries;
- d) Gas bottling plant and gas-based industries;
- e) Liquur industries;
- f) Pharmaceutical industries;
 - g) Explosive industries;

- h) Sophisticated electrical and electronic gadgets:
- i) Petroleum products and inflammable oil;
- (2) The Board of the State Government shall notify industries that would require to have licences from time to time.
- (3) The Board shall have power to issued directions in the interest and for the safety of the public,

Benami transaction

- 7. (1) Industries or industrial business establishment registerred in the name of a local person or local society, but actually owned and run by person(s) who are forbidden by law from having factory or business establishment in Mizoram, shall be deemed as "illegal industry". Such industries if detected, shall be liable to punishment with fine and in default of fine with an imprisonment as per the provison of law for the time being in force in the State of Mizoram in addition to punishment of closure of such industries.
- (2) The Board shall have the power to punish all the parties and persons involved, directly or indirectly in such benami transaction.
- (3) The Board shall also take due care while introducing joint venture, availing of investments from multinational company or any other parties from outside Mizoram, so as to protect the best interest of the State.

Mandatory

8. All Khadi and Village Industries Units engaged in Khadi and Registration Village Industries activities, assisted and financed by the Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board shall be registered, in the office of Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board.

Optional

9. It shall be optional for those Khadi and Village Industries Units. Registration which are not assisted or financed by the Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board, to get themselves registered in the Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board office. And such units shall be registered under Provisional Registration.

- Provisional 10. (1) Provisional Registration can be given to those units engaged Registration in Khadi and Village Industries activities but are not, as yet, assisted or financed by Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board.
 - (2) Persons trained at Khadi and Village Industries training institutes or centres and persons or units directly financed by Khadi and Village Industries Commission, having genuine intension of starting industries, may also seek registration on provisional basis.
 - (3) Khadi units which are already approved by State Level Advisory Certification Committee but are not yet cleared by the Central Certification Committee, shall also be eligible for Provisional Registration.

Obligatory 11. Industrial units, societies and individual who get financial assis-Registration tance from any other approved programme of the State Government or Central Government or other recognised body, through the service of Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board, shall also be registered under appropriate Code of Registration as laid down in Annexure-1.

Registering Authority

12. In all matters of registration of Industries under rules 8, 9, 10 and 11, the Chief Executive Officer or an officer authorised by him shall function as a Registering Authority and he shall exercise the power of granting registration to any unit, on behalf of the Mizeram Khadi and Village Industries Board.

- Validity of 13. (1) All registration shall remain valid so long as the unit con-Registration tinue to carry on activities by which the unit got registered, even after full repayment of loan.
 - (2) On discontinuance of such activities and on full repayment of loan and other dues, the unit may seek termination of registration.

Power of Registering Authority

- 14. (1) A registering Authority may cancel or de-register any registered industrial unit on grounds of violation of any provision of the Act and of these rules direction or orders of the Registering Authority or on grounds of illegal activities or other reasonable grounds.
- (2) Registering Authority shall not, however, cancel registration or de-register any unit on grounds of any reasons above, so long as the unit still have dues and liabilities towards Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board, or its allied organisations.
- (3) The Registering Authority shall have the right to charge reasonable amount on account of registration card. The rate of such charges fees shall be pre-determined by the Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board before such charges are imposed.

Privileges of Registered Unit

The Registered unit shal avail-

- a) Priorities for grant of stipend for further training and research works in their field of activities.
- b) Financial assistance and loans provided such funds are available with the Board and provided further that the unit fulfil such other terms and conditions;
- c) Free technical services of the technicians in matters of installation of machineries and repair works;
- d) Marketting assistance in the form of effecting sales of their products through Khadi and Village Industries' emporia, publicity and training in marketting techniques. They shall be given preference in the course of collection of goods which are meant shrough emporia of the Khadi and Village Industries;

- e) Awards and decorations instituted by the Khadi and Village Industries Commission or Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board or other recognised bodies;
- f) Any other facility or schemes or subsidies and incentive schemes introduced by the State Government, Central Government, Khadi and Village Industries Commission and Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board provided the unit can fulfil other terms and conditions prescribed.

Duties and **Obligations** of Regis-tered Units

- 16. All Registered Units are bound —
- a) to furnish reports and returns required by the Board regularly;
- b) to make repayment of loan regularly without waiting for a written reminder;
- c) to avoid engagement in any illegal activities;
- d) to report change of address and change of factory location, if any:
- e) to comply with the desitions of the Board in matter of business principles and policies and in matters of uniform prices and quality control;
- f) to obey any provision of the Act, rules or regulations enforced. by Government or Government agencies;
 - g) to insure plant and machineries which he procured with loan money, with any registered insurance company;
 - h) to hypothecate all plants and machineries, procured by him with loan money he received from Mizoram Khadi and Village Industries Board, to the Board.
 - i) to avoid sale or dispose off assets and properties acquired by him with loan money without the approval of the board so long as his loan money are not fully repaid:
- j) to comply with any written direction of the Board in matters of loans and other connected issues.

Codes and details of plant capa-CITY

- Registration 17. (1) Different groups of industries, shall be coded with abbreviated registration codes, allotted to different trades. Such codes will be prefixed by codes for district and year;
 - (2) Detail of cedes for different trades shall be as laid down in . Annexure-II. The Board shall have the power to re-arrange the codes and add new codes whenever necessary;

- (3) Person(s) or unit seeking registration must fill up declaration form in which he must declare the following information, namely—
- a) Name and address of applicants;
- b) Main trade of industry and subsidiary products;
- c) Location of factory with documentary evidence;
- d) Different kinds of machineries installed or intended to be installed, indicating model size, and capacity of the machines;
- e) Number of persons to be engaged or employed;
- f) Annual production capacity;
- g) License No. of permit, if such industries require such license or permit;
- h) Any other information as may be called by the Registering Authority.
- (4) Sample of Declaration Form is as given in Annexure-III, the format of which is liable to change from time to time.

conditions for certain industries

- Certain pre- 18. (1) An industrial unit having fixed capital investment in plants and machineries over Rs. 30.00 lakhs shall not normally be registered as village industry, unless otherwise decided by the Board. Such industrial unit must seek registration as small scale industry at the District Industries Centre.
 - 2) Any industry or business connected with Chemical, Pharmaceutical, gun, inflammable, dangerous gas, liquor, food, intoxicant items like Berdi, pan, and cigarattes etc. any hotel or sales outlet serving liquor, preparation and producing as raw materials, tapping of toddy for sale and any other industries or business connected with cultivation of crops, plantation of tea, coffee, rubber etc. sericulture activities related to coir and its products, horticulture, floriculture piggery, poultry, animal husbandry, any project producing yarn and cloth whether cotton, woolen, silk polyvastra with the help of power, textiles out of mill yarn also shall not be registered unless the unit fulfil terms and conditions imposed on such industries; provided that any of such industries which are permissible with other Government agencies may be registered with appropriate category.

Power of the Board

- 19. (1) The Board shall have power to inspect administrative office, factory and premises of the factory of a registered unit, at any time.
- (2) The Board shall have power to cancel registration on grounds of violation of any rules in force under the Board or on grounds of non-compliance of any written directions or orders issued by the Soard. Board.

- (3) The Board shall have power to impose monetary fines or penalty for any act committed by the registered unit, which are detrimental to the image and credibility of the Board or an act of commission that goes against the interest and policies of the Board, even is such act of commission may not actually mean blantant violation of law. The maximum penalty or fines imposeable may not however, exceed the amount of loan or debt outstanding against the registered unit.
- (4) The Board shall have power to close down factory of the registered unit, if any part of this rules or other rules in force under the Board, or order or direction of the Board, or law enforced by the State Government is violated by the unit.

Residuary Provision

20. Any issue connected with registration of units and subjects arising therefrom, which are not specifically provided in these rules, shall be settled by the Board, keeping in view any relevant rules and practices.
