NOTIFICATION

No A.12018/29/80-APT (B), the 20th September, 2000. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Junior Engineer (Civil) under Public Works Department and Public Health Engineering Department Government Mizoram, namely:—

- 1. Short title and Commencement.
- (i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Public Works Department and Public Health Engineering Department (Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2000.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.

The Rules shall apply to the post specified in Column—1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.

3. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of pay.

The number of the said post (s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 - 4 of the Annexure-I aforesaid.

4. Method of recruit -The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the ment, age limit said post shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the and other Annexure - I aforesaid.

qualifications.

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

- 5. Disqualification. No person
 - a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (s).

Provided that the Governors may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person dai to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

- Training and Departmental Examination.
- Every Government servant recruited under these Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
- 7. Power to transfer.

Notwithstanding anything contained to these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and power to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

8. Power to relax.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Departmental Promotion Committee /Mizoram Pandal Service Commission, as the case may be, through the Department of Personnel & Admn. Reforms, relax any of the provisions to these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

9. Reservation and other concessions.

Nothing in these Rules shall affect a preservation or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes/ and the Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government this regards.

10. Repeal and Savings.

All Rules pertaining to these posts formed by the Government of Assum or Governor of Assum and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-11MP dated 21.1.1972 or framed by the Government of Mizoram under Notification No. PWE. 97/73/225 di. 14.10.75 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 45 dt. 31.10.75 are nereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
