NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/29/80-APT (B), the 20th September, 2000. In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Section Assistant under Public Works Department and Public Health Engineering Department, Government of Mizoram, namely:-

- Short title and commencement.
- These Rules may be called the Mizoram Public Works (i) Department and Public Health Engineering Department (Group 'C' Post) -Recruitment Rules, 2000.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application.
- The Rules shall apply to the post specified in column-1 of the Annexure - I hereto annexed.
- 3. Number of of pay.
 - The number of the said post (s), their classification and the posts, classifica- scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in tion and scale columns 2-4 of the Annexure - I aforesaid.
- Method of recruitment, age qualifications.
 - The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post snall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the limit and other Annexure-I aforesaid.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/or the Schedul d Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

- 5. Disquali-No person fication.
 - (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

b) whe, having a spouse living, has a forced into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be aligible for appointment to the said post(s).

Provided that the Governor is if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the proposal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these Rules.

- 6. Training and Departmental Examination.
- Every Govt, servant recruited and these Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Described Examinations as may be prescribed from time to it.
- 7. Power to transfer.

Notwithstanding anything contains on these Rules, the Governor of Mizotam in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any Office. The rules to any other post or positive which is equivalent in rank or grade.

8. Power to relax.

9. Reservation and other concessions.
