Whereas consequent upon the severance of ties and connection from the MDF-MNF joint Legislature party of Mara Autonomous District Council by the 6 MDCs namely Pu Lengduna, Pu N.Viakhu, Pu I.P.Junior, Pu L.Khaichnyu, Pu S. Lalremthanga and Pi Lalbiaktluangi Sailo and the declaration of the 7 elected members of the Mara Autonomous District Council belonging to Congress party of their joining the MNF legislature party on 3.11.2000.

And whereas a joint petition has been submitted to His Exellency the Governor of Mizoram by the 13 MDCs namely Pu Lengduna, Pu N. Viakhu, Pu 1.P. Junior, Pu L. Khaichhyu, Pu S. Lalremtnanga, Pi Lalbiaktluangi Sailo, Pu S. Khipo, Pu R.T. Zachono, Pu F.C. Zase, Pu Nohro Hmoko, Pu N. Zakhai, Pu V. Vanhupa and Pu K. Hrahmo stating that they have no longer confidence in the Executive Committee of the Mara Autonomous District Council headed by Pu P.P. Thawla Chief Executive Member on ground of manucial mismanagement and his failure to run the administration to reach and cover all sections of the people apart from those belonging to his party etc. and therefore requesting him for urgent summoning of the sitting of the District Council under Sub-rule 5 of rule 37 of the Autonomous Listrict Council (CCs) Kules 1974;
