No. LJD. 29/74/15, the 1st. April, 1974. The following Act passed by the Mizoram Legislative Assembly and assented to by the Administrator of Mizoram is hereby published for general information.

Mizoram Act No. 4 of 1974.

The Appropriation (No. 1) ACT 1974.

(Received the assent of the Administrator on 30th. March, 1974).

AN

ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Mizoram to the services for the period from 1st. April, 1973 to 31st. March, 1974.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Twenty fifth year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (No. I) Act, 1974. Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in columns 3 of the schedule amounting to the sum of Rupees eight Crores twenty five lakhs forty two thousand five hundred only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1973-74 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram by the Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the schedule in relation to the period from 1. 4. 73-31. 3. 74.

Mizoram Act No. 5 1974.

The Appropriation (No. 2) ACT 1974.

(Received the assent of the Administrator on 30th. March, 1974).

AN

ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Mizoram to the services for the period from 1st. April, 1974 to 31st. March, 1975.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Twenty fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Bill may be called the Appropriation (No. 2) Bill 1974.
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the schedule amounting to the sum of Rupees Twenty eight crores eighty seven lakhs and thirty seven thousand only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1974—75 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram by the Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the schedule in relation to the period from 1. 4. 74. to 31. 3 1975.
