No. LJD. 49/72/38, the 1st. April, 1974. The following notifications issued by Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi and Published in Gazette of India extra ordinary Part II dated 20th. March, 1974, are hereby re-published for general information.

New Delhi; the 20th. March, 1974.

- In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control and until further orders, the powers and functions of the State Government under cluse (8) of section 2, sections 20, 21 and 22, sub-section (2) of section 108, clause (b) of section (1) of section 132, sections 133, 134, 143 and 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974) shall, in relation to the Union Territory of Arunachai Pradesh or Union territory of Mizoram, be exercised and discharged also by the Administrator of that Union Territory.
- 2. This notification shall come into force on the 1st. day of April, 1974.

No. LJD. 49/72/39, the 1st April, 1974. The following Notifications issued by Government of India, under U.O. No.4-11011/2/74-UTL-(II) dated 20th March, 1973 are hereby republished for general information:—

"In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-section (2) of exection 1 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), the Central Go-

vernment hereby applies to the Union Territories of Arunachal Pradesh and Mizoram being tribal areas within the meaning of the Explanation to the said proviso, with effect from the 1st day of April, 1974, the provisions of the said Code, as mentioned in Column (1) of the Schedule hereto annexed, to the extent, and subject to the modifications, if any, specified in column (2) of the said Schedule.

- Section 2 To the extent the definitions contained therein apply for the interpretation of the provisions extended by this notification and those contained in Chapter VIII, X and XI of the Code.
- Section 3 After sub-section (4), the following sub-section shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "(5) Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this section—
 - (i) any reference in such of the provisions of this Code, as apply to the Union Territories of Arunachal Pradesh and Mizoram, to the Court mentioned in column (1) of the Table below shall, until the Courts of Session and Courts of Judicial Magistrates are constituted in the said Union Territories, be construed as references to the Court of Magistrate mentioned in the corresponding entry in column (2) of that Table.
