The Mizoram (Revenue Assessment)

A Bill

to amend the Lushai Hills District (Revenue Assessment) Regulation, 1953.

Preamble

Whereas it is expedient to amend subsection (10) of Section 3 of the Lushai Hills District (Revenue Assessment) Regulation, 1953, (Regulation No. 4 of 1953) concerning the rate of fee in the manner hereinafter appearing; it is hereby enacted in the Twenty fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title extent and commence-

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Mizoram (Revenue Assessment) (Amendment) Regulation, 1974.

- (2) It extends to the whole of the Union Territory of Mizoram excluding Chhimtuipui District.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of sub-section (10) of Section 3 of Regulation No.4 of 1953.

2. For sub-section (10) of section 3, the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:—

"(10) Every issue of Pass, original of duplicate for wet rice cultivation, garden, house, shop, stall and other building assessable under this Regulation shall be made only on payment of fee as may be fixed by the Administrator from time to time".

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

To enable the Administrator to fix rate of fee as circumstances may demand, amendment of sub-section (10) of Section 3 of the Regulation is considered necessary. Hence the Bill.
