The terms of reference and functions of the Committee will be :—

- i) To advise on all matters pertaining to Planning and Co-ordination of policies, standard of safety in the Road Transport sector.
- ii) To formulate and recommend road safety programmes for implementation by the Road Safety Organisation as also other State Agencies in charge of Road Transportation.

- iii) To suggest areas for research and development to improve safety aspects in the Road Transport sector, including maintenance of statistics or road accidents and their analysis.
- iv) To generally oversee and monitor the road safety measures undertaken by the state agencies.
- v) The Committee shall decide the procedure and methodology to be adopted for their respective functioning.
- vi) Non-Official and outstanding members shall be entitled to TA/DA as admissible to Grade I Officers of Govt. of Mizoram and as admissible under rules of Mizoram salaries, allowances and pension of member of Legislative Assembly Act, 1987.
- vii) The Committee shall ensure through concerned Agencies of the Department the formulation of Action Plan on Road Safety Schemes/measures.
- viii) The Special Road Safety Cell shall provide secretariat assistance to the Committee and also co-ordinate Road Safety Plans, measures and monitor their implementation and submit it reports to the Committee.
