NOTIFICATION

No.B.13019/1/88-SYS, the 2nd August, 2001 : Whereas the Government of Mizoram considers it expedient to lay down Rules for sanction of lumpsum Cash Award to the winners of Medals in National and International Competitions in recognised Sports Disciplines including Adventure Sports, the Governor of Mizoram hereby makes the following Rules-which shall come into effective from the date of publish in the Mizoram Gazette.

Short title and commencement 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Sports Incentive Cash Award Rules, 2001.
(2) They shall come into force immediately after publication in the official Mizoram Gazette.

Definitions

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires :-

- (a) "Adventure Sports" Adventure Sports are those unusual sports activities, mainly involving high risk manouvers. It includes, Mountaineering, Rock Climbing, Trekking, Base-Jumping, Bangu-Jumping, Sports Climbing, Long Distance Cycle Race, Hang-Gliding, Para-Sailing Ballooning, Micro-light-flying, Sky-Diving, Kayaking and Canoeing, White water Rafting, Deep-Sea-Diving, Cave-Diving etc. These Adventure activities had recently been accepted as Sports activities and competitions are being regularly held at the National and International Level.
- (b) "Government" means the Government of Mizoram.
- (c) "Governing Bodies" means State Level Sports Association duly affiliated to the National Federation which is recognised by the Government of India;

- (d) "International Championship" means the Championship deems fit to be participated in by the Respective National Federations;
- (e) "Medal Winner" means winner of Gold Medal or Silver Medal or Bronze Medal in any National or International Championships or Tournament or competitions in recognised Sports Disciplines including Adventure Sports;
- (f) "National Championship" means Championship duly recognised by respective National Sports Federations affiliated to India Olympics Association;
- (g) "National Games" means any National Games organised by Indian Olympic Associations ;
- (h) "State" means the State of Mizoram.

Objectives

3. The objective of the Mizoram Sports incentive Cash Award 2001 are :-
 - (a) to ensure the outstanding Sports persons and adventurers of the State are given special recognition by giving Incentive Cash Award so that it will act as an Incentive to other talented Sports person to emulate their feats/performance in all levels of competitions;
 - (b) to inculcate the spirit of Discipline and Determination amongst the Athletes; and
 - (c) to inculcate a sense of being looked after and a feeling of security for having excelled in his/her choosen discipline.

Eligibility

4. The following Sports persons shall be eligible for Cash Awards.
 - (1) A person must be a Resident of Mizoram, representing any state of the Union or Sports Control Boards or the Country.
 - (2) Winner of first, second or third position in the specified Championship as enumerated in Column 2 of Annexure.
 - (3) officials, Manager, Coach, Masseur, Doctor will also be entitled to receive 25% of the Award applicable to the Sports persons.
 - (4) Any Sports person of Mizoram representing the Country in any recognised Sports Discipline in any International Sports or Championship will be entitled to receive Rs. 10,000/- as Sports Kits allowance.

- (5) For the purpose of awarding the Incentive Cash Award, there can be only one Award in one Sports Discipline in a Championship or Tournament.

Award of Increment

5. Award of Increment to Sports persons serving under the Central or State Government who excel at National and International shall be considered as defined in F.R-27 in addition to the Incentive Cash Award.

Competent Authority

6. The competent Authority for the purpose of this Award shall be the Board, comprising of the following members :-

Application

7. The eligible Sports persons for Award of Increment or Incentive Cash Award shall apply for the Award through respective Association in a prescribed proforma available in the Department within a period of six months from the date of completion of the Championship.

Residuary Power

8. In case of any situation or circumstances not specifically covered in the Rules, the competent Authority under Rule 6 shall have residuary powers to make decision.
