## **OBITUARY**

The Government of Mizoram has learnt with deep sorrow the untimely demise of Pu Ibrahim Ali, Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Aizawl on the 9th August, 2001 at about 3:00 a.m. at Civil Hospital, Aizawl due to Hypertension.

Born on 20.1.1944, Pu Ibrahim Ali was appointed Junior Inspector of Co-operative Societies under the erstwhile Assam Government on 1.2.1969. Rising through the ranks he was promoted to the present post of Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies on 15.3.1996.

At the height of Mizoram disturbances, he also served as Administrative Officer in the remotest places in the east and the southern corner of Mizoram.

Pu Ibrahim hails from Maigram village in Badarpur District of Assam and is survived by his wife, two sons and two daughters.

Pu Ibrahim Ali had been devoted and hard working Officer who had done extremely well in his carrier.

The Government places on record its appreciation of the sincere services rendered by him and conveys its heartfelt sympathy to the bereaved family.
