#### **NOTIFICATION**

No. A. 12018/3/82-APT(B)/Vol-I the 13th August, 2001. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Posts of Social Work Teacher, Case Worker, Nutritionist, Health Instructor and Pre-School Instructor under Social Welfare Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :—

1. Short title and Commencement.
  - (i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Social Welfare Department (Group 'B' post) Recruitment Rules, 2001.
  - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. These Rules shall apply to the post specified in Column— 1 of the Annexure-I here to annex.d.
3. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of pay. The number of the said posts their classification and the scale of pay hereto shall be as specified in Columns 2, 3 and 4 of the said Annexure-I.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the said Annexure - I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.
5. Disqualification. No person—
  - a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

- b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Governor may if satisfied under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

6. Training and Departmental Examination. Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examinations as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. Power to relax. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Mizoram Public Service Commission through Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
8. Power to Transfer. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
9. Reservation and other concessions. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.
10. Repeal and Savings. All Rules to these posts framed by Government of Assam or Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMP dt. 21.1.1977 or framed by the Government of Mizoram vide Notification No. A. 12018/3/82-APT(B) dt. 17.11.1986 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 75(A) dt. 17.11.1986, in respect of the posts of Social Work Teacher, Health Instructor and Pre-School Instructor No. A. 12018/3/82-APT(B) dt. 6.12.1988 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 135(E) dt. 6.12.1988, in respect of the post of Case Worker, No. A. 12018/3/81-APT(B) dt. 31.8.1987 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 93 dt. 31.8.1987, in respect of Nutritionist are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
