**THE TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE SAID SOCIETY WILL BE AS FOLLOWS :—**

- (1) Use of Sputum Examination as the primary method of diagnosis amongst self-reporting patients.
- (2) Standardised treatment regimens

- (3) Augmentation of peripheral level supervision through the creation of a Sub-District supervisory unit.
- (4) Ensuring a regular, uninterrupted supply of drug upto the most peripheral level.
- (5) Augmentation of organisational support of Central and State levels for meaningful coordination.
- (6) Place emphasis on Training, IEC, Operational Research and NGO involvement in the programme.
- (7) Increase budgetary outlay.
