NOTIFICATION

No.B.16011/13/2000-SERI, the 12th September, 2001. Whereas the Government of Mizoram deems it expedient to extend adequate assistance within the limits of its financial resources in the shape of subsidy to the deserving private Sericulturists, the Governor of Mizoram is believe pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. SHORT TITLE, EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT:

- 1) These Rules, may be called the Mizoram Sericultural Subsidies (Amendment) Rules, 2001.
- 2) They shall apply to all persons residing permanently in Mizoram, who are willing to start, expand, modernise or diversify any of the tollowing namely:
 - a) Mulberry Plantation
 - b) Silkworm Rearing
 - c) Silk Reeling
 - d) Silk Spinning
 - e) Silk Quilt and Carpet making
 - f) Silk weaving
 - 3) They shall come into force with immediate effect,
- 2. In the Mizoram Sericultural subsidy Rules, 1994, for Rule 5, the following Rule shall be substituted as under:—

RULE 5: Monetary Limits:

Subsidy shall be given to selected beneficiaries as per the following ceilings namely:

A. Subsidy on Rearing Trays Chandrakies, Rearing Nets, Parafin papers, Foam pads Silkworm eggs (disease free Layings), cutting, sapling seedlings/seeds of silkworm food plants.

75% shall be subsidised there will be no monetary limits. The beneficiary have to bear 25% of the actual cost for each items.

B. Subsidy on Fertilisers and Disinfectants.

50% shall be subsidised from the printed price and there will be no monetary limit for each items.

C. Subsidy on plant and Machinery.

50% shall be subsidised and there will be no monetary limit.

D. Subsidy on Barbed wire and other fencing materials.

25% of the actual cost shall be subsidised and there will be no monetary limit.

E. Subsidy on construction of Rearing House.

50% of the actual cost (Standard Rearing House specified by the Department) and there will be no monetary limit.

NCTE: There shall not be a selection committee for A & B as the items shall be made readily available in Departmental Store on payment at subsidised rates stipulated above.
