NOTIFICATION

No. B. 12012/18/01-FST, the 17th October, 2001. Whereas the Govt. of Mizoram considers that the area, situation and limits of which are specified in the Schedule below is of adequate ecological, faunal, floral and geomorphological importance.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred under Section 18 read with Section 19, 20 and 21 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, the Govt. of Mizoram hereby intend to declare the said area to be Wildlife Sanctuary known as "PALAK LAKE WILDLIFE SANCTUARY" for protecting, propagating and developing of Wildlife and its environment.

SCHEDULE

Name of the area : Palak Lake Wildlife Sanctuary.

Location : It is situated above 87 Km from Saiha within the Saiha District.

Area : 15.50 Sq. Kms.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

NORTH : The boundary starts from the junction point of PWD road and Agriculture Link road and runs along the Agriculture Department link road towards north and ends just between Wooded Forest and bamboo forest.

EAST : Thence the boundary runs towards east on the lake hillock and meets Diabo stream and then runs towards Moko stream entrailing liapah-lo hillock and meets the mouth of Moko stream.

- SOUTH** : Thence it runs straightly towards Shri Ialo's Garden by crossing Agriculture department link road to Supha and meet the said Garden.
- WEST** : The boundary again runs along the northern boundary of Ialo's Garden and Zali's Garden and then straightly went to the starting point.
