- (b) Programme implementation of Malaria in the State of Mizoram.
- (c) Monitoring and evaluation of the programme in the State.
- (d) To look into the operational activities whether they are as per the norm of the Govt. of India.

- (e) To utilise cash assistance received from the Govt. of India for the operational cost as per the Govt. of India guidance.
- (f) To submit expenditure report including utilisation Certificate as per the norms of the Govt. of India.
- (g) To assess and procure materials and equipments required for the implementation of the programme promptly for its successful implementation.
- (h) To see the overall achievement and progress thereof including the loophole to implement the programme successfully.
- (i) The Society will be responsible to frame Rules and Regulations of its own in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India issued from time to time.
- (j) To co-ordinate with other agencies like non Government organisation, church leaders etc. for implementation of the programme.
