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#### **NOTIFICATION**

No. HC. XI-06(pt) 96/735/RC, the 10th October, 2001. In exercise of the powers conferred under Article 229 the Constitution of India, the Hon'ble Chief Justice is pleased to make the following amendment to the Gauhati High Court Services (Appointment Condition of Services and Conduct) Rules, 1967 by way of insertion of sub-rule (5) to Rule 7 of the said Rules for appointment, promotion etc. to the post of Court Master, as follows:-

- “Method/Procedure of recruitment :** The post of Court Master may be filled up by selection, on the basis of merit-cum-seniority, from amongst the UDAs/LDAs working at the Principal” Seat of the Gauhati High Court having 8 years of experience as UDA/LDA or both combined. Preference may be given to UDAs/LDAs having Degree of Law from any recognized University.
- Nature of appointment :** The appointment to the post of Court Master will be temporary and subject to review every year, Selection and appointment of an employee as Court Master will not be treated as his/her promotion.
- Pay :** Rs.4210-90-4480-120-5200-175-5725-EB-175-6600-250-8100-325-10,375/- PM and as may be revised from time to time plus allowances as admissible.
- Status :** Gazetted,  
(Class-II-DD, Services of the Gauhati High Court)
- Promotion :** An employee from the UDA cadre holding the post of Court Master will be considered for promotion as Superintendent as per his/her own seniority in the rank

of UDA. The LDA, holding the post of Court Master will be considered for promotion to the post of Superintendent on the basis of his/her seniority as may be determined on his/her national date of promotion to the rank of UDA, i.e., the date when his/her turned for promotion as UDA would have come.

**Seniority** : Seniority of an employee, holding the post of Court Master, will be maintained in the original post/cadre of the employee concerned, irrespective of his/her placement as Court Master. Holding of the post of Court Master, by itself, will not entitle an employee to claim any promotion over his/her senior in the original post/cadre.

**Reversion** : Prayer for reversion to the original post, if made by an employee, holding the post of Court Master, may be allowed at the discretion of the authority concerned.

Schedule-I of the said Service Rules shall also stand modified accordingly.”

The amendment will come into force with immediate effect.
