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NOTIFICATION

No.B.12012/1/91-EST, the 16th November, 2001. Whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sec-1 of Sec-18 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, the Governor of Mizoram by reason of the adequate ecological, faunal, floral, geomorphological, natural or zoological significance has declared his intention vide Notification No.FOR.15-C/74-78/21 dt. 29.11.78 to constitute the area specified in the schedule to this Notification as "Wildlife Sanctuary" for the purpose of protecting, propagating or developing wildlife therein and its environment.

Whereas, as envisaged by sec-19 of the Indian Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and as directed by the Govt. of Mizoram in the said Notification, the District Collector, Aizawl District has carried out an enquiry into the existence, nature and extent of right of person over the land comprised within the limits of proposed Tawi Wildlife Sanctuary.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sec-26-A(I) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, the Governor of Mizoram hereby declares the above said area as specified in the Schedule below as Tawi Wildlife Sanctuary with effect from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

SCHEDULE

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| Area | : 35.75 Sq. Kms. |
| Boundary description | : The boundary of Tawi Wildlife Sanctuary will be as follows:- |
| NORTH | : Starting from the source of Khuailui stream the boundary goes towards North crossing above the Khuaimual (Hill ridge) upto the water point (INTAKE) constructed for Lungvel water supply. It then follows Yawmhrawblui upstreams upto Tawizo saddle (Liamkawn). |

- EAST** : From the saddle (Liamkawn) it goes towards south following Maite Jeep road upto the source of Vaidanlui along the foot hills. And then it goes to a small lake above Hruiuai crossing the lake upto Bak puk. It then goes to Jhum land of Khuaihnuai and meets source of Khuailui (stream). It then goes to Riahbuk mual and meets Maite Jeep road. It then goes along the foothills catching Hmuatha road upto the place called Lungmite.
- SOUTH** : From Lungmite it follows the foothills of Tawi hill towards north-west direction and then crossed Saza stream and then meets Bengchatlui (stream).
- WEST** : From Bengchatlui (stream) source it follows the foothills towards north. It then meets river source of R. Tuikum and then crossing Kawihawk kah kawn (saddle) and meets Khuailui (stream) the starting point of northern boundary.

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
