REGULARISATION OF MUSTER ROLL EMPLOYEES SCHEME, 2000.

1. **Preamble** : This Scheme is formulated for giving scope for regularisation of Muster Roll Employees to regular posts under the Government of Mizoram in the light of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's directive reported in AIR, 1992 SC 2130 as well as the Cabinet decision dt. 18. 12. '99.

2. **Short Title and commencement** : This Scheme shall be called "Regularisation of Muster Roll Employees in the Law and Judicial Department of the Government of Mizoram Scheme, 2000".

It shall come into force at once.

3. **Application** : This Scheme shall apply to all Muster Roll Employees in Group 'C' and 'D' categories under law and Judicial Department who were duly employed by means of engagement orders/cards issued by the competent authority.

4. **Regularisation** : (i) Any person who has been continuously engaged in Muster Roll capacity in Group 'C' or 'D' categories in the Law and Judicial Department for at least five years shall be eligible for regularisation in corresponding regular post prescribed for direct recruitment in the concerned Recruitment Rules, subject to availability of vacancy.

Provided that such Muster Roll Employees possesses the required educational and other qualifications prescribed in the relevant Recruitment Rules.

Provided further that such regularisation shall be made subject to satisfactory performance reports for the last five years, prepared by the Controlling Officers.

(ii) 25% vacant posts under direct recruitment may be reserved for Muster Roll Employees or as the Govt. may determine from time to time.

5. **Condonation of Age** : Age of a Muster Roll Employees may, while being considered for appointment to a regular post, be condoned by the Government unless such an employee was already overaged at the time of initial engagement, for such regular appointment.
6. **Regularisation not as of right** : Notwithstanding anything contained in this Scheme, such regularisation shall not be claimed by any Muster Roll Employee as matter as of right.
