THE CENTRAL EXCISE TARIFF (AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 2002

No. 1 of 2002

Promulgated by the President in the fifty-second
Year of the Republic of India.

An Ordinance further to amend the Central Excise
Tariff Act, 1985.

WHEREAS Parliament is not in session and the
President is satisfied that circumstances exist which ren-
der it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Central Excise Tariff (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 3 of Act 5 of 1986.

2. In section 3 of the Central Excise Tariff Act, 1985, in sub-section (I), for clause (b), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(b) in any other case, a rate of duty as it thinks necessary.”
