#### **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

No. D. 21012/2/96-TRP/Pt, the 7th May, 2002. It has been notified that in the existing Guidelines for disposal of condemned Govt. vehicles notified vide No. D. 21012/2/97-TRP dt. 12. 8. 97 there is no time-frame laid down for submission of proposal for condemnation of Govt. vehicles. As a result, most of the Departments are in the habit of submitting proposals thereof after a lapse of even some years from the date of off-roading Govt. vehicles and this causes further deterioration/damage to the off-roaded vehicles resulting in heavy loss of Govt. revenues.

Therefore, in order to avoid further loss of Govt. revenues on this account, the undersigned is directed to request all Heads of Departments to submit all proposals for condemnation of Govt. vehicles within 60 (sixty) days from the date of off-roading such vehicles to the Director of Transport, Govt. of Mizoram henceforth.
