OFFICE MEMORANDUM

No. D. 21012/2/92-TRP/Pt-II, the 27th May, 2002. It has been noticed that some Govt. Departments are reportedly disposing Govt. vehicles fraudulently and some retiring Officers have been given the advantage of taking such vehicles on direct allotment basis against extant rules. Therefore, in order to stop such illegal practices, the undersigned is directed to remind all Heads of Deptts, and all other concerned to strictly follow rules and procedures laid down in the existing guidelines for disposal of condemned Govt. Vehicles notified vide this Deptt's O. M. No. D. 21012/2/97-TRP dt. 12. 8. 1997 and No. D. 21012/2/96-TRP/Pt dt. 7. 5. 02 for disposal of Condemned Vehicles duly approved by vehicle Condemnation Board only and not to dispose off vehicle not yet condemned by the Vehicles Condemnation Board duly appointed by the Govt. of Mizoram.
