NOTIFICATION

No.C.11011/1/93-EDN(HTE), the 15th July, 2002. Whereas the State of Mizoram has no facilities for Higher Technical Studies within the State;

And whereas the seats allotted to the State of Mizoram for Higher and Technical Studies by the Central Government is insufficient to meet the requirement of Technical manpower in the State;

And whereas the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court vide its judgement dt.26.9.2000 in Civil Rule (P.L) No. 1239 of 1994 struck down the provision of sub-rule (3) of rule 5 of the Mizoram (Selection of Candidates for Higher Technical Courses) Rules, 1999;

And whereas the State Government of Mizoram deems it expedient to have fair selection of promising candidates only for those limited seats offered and to strike some reasonable balance of reservation of seats for the different categories of candidates;

Now, therefore, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules to amend the Mizoram (Selection of Candidates for Higher Technical Courses) Rules, 1999, namely -

1. Short title and commencement:

- (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram (Selection of Candidates for Higher Technical Courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2002.
- (2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of Rule 5(3) : The whole portion of Rule 5(3) of the Principal Rule shall be deleted and replaced by the following:

"Allotment of seats shall be made in the following order :-

- 1) Category-I : Children of local permanent residents-85%
- 2) Category-II : Children of Non Local permanent residents-10%
- 3) Category-III : Children of Central and other State Government employees posted in the State who have completed not less than 2 years in Mizoram on the last day of submission of application - 5%.
