#### **NOTIFICATION**

No B. 17011/11/2002-EDN, the 1st August, 2002. In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (i) of Rule 20 of the Mizoram Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Mission Rules, 2001, the Executive Committee is pleased to make the following regulations to regulate the conditions of services of employees working under Mizoram Sarva Saiksha Abhiyan Rajya Mission.

- Short title and commencement
1. (1) These regulations may be called the Mizoram Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Rajya Mission (Conditions of Service) Regulations 2002.  
(2) It shall come into force from the date appointed by the Executive Committee.
  2. In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires :
    - a) "Department" means School Education Department;
    - b) "Executive Committee" means the body which is constituted under Rule 21 of the Mizoram Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Rajya Mission Rules, 2001;
    - c) "Governing Body" means the body constituted under Rule 5 of the Mizoram Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Rajya Mission Rules, 2001.
    - d) "Government" means the State Government of Mizoram;
    - e) "Mission" means the Mizoram Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Rajya Mission;

f) "Officers and staff" means all whole time and part-time employees of the Mission appointed by the Government, Executive Committee or by any authority or officer duly empowered to do so;

g) "State Project Director" means the officer appointed by Government to be the State Project Director for the purpose of these regulations.

**Appoint-  
ment of offi-  
cers and staff**

3. (1) The State Project Director may appoint on deputation such number of officers and staff on whole time basis subject to the approval of the Executive Committee to assist him in the administration and management of the affairs of the Mission.

(2) The officers and staff so appointed shall necessarily be from the employees of the Department and shall hold their lien in their parent Department;

(3) The designation and nomenclature of the officers and staff shall be fixed by the State Project Director in consultation with the Executive Committee.

(4) They shall hold their office at the pleasure of the Executive Committee.

**Pay and  
Allowances**

4. (1) The scale of pay of officers and staff of the Project office so appointed must normally be equal to their scale of pay in the parent Department. However, the Executive Committee in consultation with the Governing Body may allow such officers and staff to enjoy a higher scale of pay as deems fit.

(2) All officers and staff of the project office shall be paid from the Government unless the expenditure is expressly borne by Government of India.

(3) All officers and staff of the project office shall not be allowed deputation allowance unless expressly permitted by the Executive Committee.

**Other Ser-  
vice matters**

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, in all other matters of service existing rules in force which governed the Government servants shall be applicable to the officers and staff of the Project Office.

**Regulation  
to be in ad-  
dition to any  
other rules**

6. The provisions of this regulation shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of any other rules for the time being in force, which govern the Government servants.

- Interpreta- 7. If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these re-  
tion gulations it shall be referred to the Executive Committee and  
the decision of the Executive Committee shall be final.
- Removal 8. If any difficulty arises in the working of these regulations, the  
of difficulty Executive Committee in consultation with the Governing Body  
may makes such order or do such thing not inconsistent with  
the Mizoram Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Rajya Mission Rules 2001  
as it appears it to be necessary or expedient in removing the  
difficulty.
