### THE APPROPRIATION (RAILWAYS) VOTE ON ACCOUNT ACT, 2002

#### AN ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India for the services of a part of the financial year 2002-03 for the purposes of Railways.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows :--

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Railways) Vote Short title. on Account Act, 2002.
