NOTIFICATION

No. C. 11011/1/93-EDN(HTE), the 7th October, 2002. In exercise of powers conferred under proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make Rules as follows, namely:—

- 1) Short title and commencement:
 - a) These Rules may be called the Mizoram (Selection of Candidates for Higher Technical Courses) (Second Amendment) Rules, 2002.
 - b) They shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2) Amendment of clause (d) of rule 4—In the Mizoram (Selection of Candidates for Higher Technical Courses) Rules, 1999 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules, for clause (d) of rule 4, the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(d) have obtained not less than fifty per cent of the marks in aggregate in the subjects concerned; Provided that the minimum percentage of marks for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other backward Classes shall be forty five per cent in aggregate in the subjects concerned”.

- 3) Amendment of Explanation below sub-rule (1) of rule 5.—In the Principal Rules, after the last sentence of the explanation of sub-rule (1) of rule 5, the following clause shall be added, namely:—

“Children of deceased employees of the State Government other than those mentioned in clause (a) whose families are living in Mizoram shall also be eligible”.
