No. B. 17013/2/2001-EDC, the 12th November, 2002. As a measure to ensure meaningful development, maintenance of academic excellence and improve standard in higher Education, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to upgrade the amalgamated Colleges viz. Johnson College and L& J College to Deficits Status with effect from 1.11.2002 on condition that the requirement and recruitment of teaching and non-teaching staff shall be strictly assessed and screened as per University Grants Commission norms and that the newly upgraded Colleges shall have day class only.

The management of the College and other service conditions of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the upgraded Colleges will be governed by the Rules as framed and amended for the Aided College from time to time.

This issues with the approval of the Council of Ministers in its meeting held on 21.8.2002 (Ref. Memo No. J. 11012/2/2002-POL(Vol. I) dt. 23.8.2002).
