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NOTIFICATION

No. K. 12011/3/96-REV, the 18th November, 2002. Whereas by Government Notification K. 12011/3/96-REV, Dt. 20. 8. 2001 published in the Official Gazette and two daily newspaper, it was notified under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central) Act 1 of 1894 (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act") that the land specified in the Schedule appended to the said Notification was likely to be needed for the purpose namely Acquisition of land for construction of Tuirial Hydro Electricity Project 2nd phase.

And whereas the appropriate Government (hereinafter referred to as the "Government of Mizoram after considering the report made under sub-section (2) of the section 5 (A) of the said Act is satisfied that the land is needed for the purpose specified above.

Now, therefore, the Government declare under section 6 of the said Act that the said land is required for the public purpose specified above.

The Government also appoints Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl under clause (c) of section 3 of the said Act to perform the functions of a Collector for all proceedings hereinafter to be taken in respect of the said land and directs him under section 7 of the said Act to take order for the acquisition of the said land.

The Collector shall thereupon cause the land to be measured and make a plan of the same under Section 8 of the said Act if not already done as per section 4 of the said Act, and dispose of all objections and claims after causing a public notice for not less than 15 days to the persons interested stating the Government is intention of taking over the possession of the said land as per section 9 of the said Act. Then, the Collector shall submit a draft Award to the Government of Mizoram after fulfilling the provisions under section 11 of the said Act.

A plan of the said can be inspected at the Office of the D. C. Aizawl till the final award is made under section 11 of the said Act.

And whereas the Government (hereinafter referred to as the Government) has been authorized by the report made under sub-section (2) of the said Act to acquire the said land for the purpose specified above.

Now, therefore, the Government declares under section 6 of the said Act that the said land is required for the public purpose specified above.

The Government has also appointed Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl under clause (c) of section 3 of the said Act to perform the functions of a Collector for all proceedings hereinafter to be taken in respect of the said land and directs him under section 7 of the said Act to take order for the acquisition of the said land.

The Collector is directed to cause the land to be measured and make a plan of the same under section 8 of the said Act if not already done as per section 4 of the said Act and deposit of all objections and claims after causing a public notice to be given for 15 days to the persons interested stating the Government's intention of taking over the possession of the said land as per section 9 of the said Act. The Collector shall submit a draft Award to the Government of Mizoram after including the provisions of section 11 of the said Act.

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
