NOTIFICATIONS

No.B.12012/20/02-FST, the 27th November, 2002. Whereas the Government of Mizoram considers that the area, situation and limits of which are specified in the schedule below is of adequate ecological, floral, faunal and Geomorphological importance.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred under Section 18 of the wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 (Central Act 53 of 1972), the Government of Mizoram hereby intends to declare the said area to be an wildlife sanctuary known as "Sinemon Wildlife Sanctuary" for protecting, propagating and developing of wildlife and its environment.

Hunting, shooting, killing, causing injury, capturing, poisoning, killing with explosives, snaring, trapping of any wild animal, damaging or disturbing the eggs or nests of wild birds and reptiles, grazing of domestic animals, setting fire, clearing or felling of any vegetation and collection of any forest produce from the sanctuary are henceforth strictly prohibited.

SCHEDULE

Name of the Area : Sinemon Wildlife Sanctuary.
District : Chakma Autonomous District Council.
Location : Near Kamtuli Village, Parva.
Area : 143 Sq. Km.

BOUNDARIES OF SINEMON WILDLIFE SANCTUARY:

- NORTH** : Silosora and Bangladesh.
- SOUTH** : Tuichawng river and Trijuncture.
- EAST** : Jeep road, Kamtali village, Parva river, Tuichawng river.
- WEST** : Bangladesh.
