The Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2003 (Act No. 3 of 2003)

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 27th March, 2003.)

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services in respect of the month of April-July, 2003.

It is enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Fifty Fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short Title

Issue of Rs. 460,32,56,000/-
out of the Consolidated
Fund of the State of
Mizoram for the month
of April-July, 2003.

Appropriation

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) (No. 2) Act, 2003.
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied the sums not exceeding those as specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act, amounting in the aggregate to a sum of Rupees Four hundred sixty crore, thirty two lakh and fifty six thousand only towards "Vote on Account" for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the month of April-July 2003 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.
3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
