NOTIFICATION

No.C. 31019/3/94-AH&V/229, the 26th May, 2003. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Driver under Mizoram State Veterinary Council; namely :-

Short title and commencement

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Veterinary Council Rules (Recruitment of Driver), 2002.

They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

Application

2. These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.

Number of posts, Classification and scale of pay:

3. The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 to the Schedule aforesaid.

Method of recruitment, Age limit and other Qualification.

4. The method or Recruitment, age limit and other qualification relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Col. 5 to 10 of the said scheduled.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Govt. or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

Disqualification

5. No person—

(a) Who has entered into or contracted marriage with a person having a spouse living,

(b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other grounds to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these Rules.

Training and Departmental Examination.

6. Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

Power to Relax

7. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department Administrative Reforms relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Reservation and other Concessions

8. Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other categories of person in accordance with the order issued by the Central Govt. or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
