THE SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF OFFICERS OF PARLIAMENT AND LEADERS OF OPPOSITION IN PARLIAMENT (SECOND AMENDMENT) ACT 2002.

AN ACT

further to amend the Salaries and Allowances of Officers of Parliament Act, 1953 and the Salary and Allowances of Leaders of Opposition in Parliament Act, 1977.

It is enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

CHAPTER I

PRELIMINARY

I. (I) This Act may be called the Salaries and Short title Allowances of Officers of Parliament and Leaders of and com-Opposition in Parliament (Second Amendment) Act, mencement. 2002.

CHAPTER II

AMEN**MENT TO THE SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF OFFICERS** OF PARLIAMENT ACT, 1953.
