#### **THE APPROPRIATION (RAILWAYS) No. 3 ACT, 2003**

##### **AN ACT**

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India for the services of the financial year 2003-04 for the purposes of Railways.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Railways) No. 3 Act, 2003. **Short title**
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of India there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Appropriation (Railways) No. 3 Act, 2003] the sum of Rs. 77271, 43,14,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of India. **Issue of Rs. 77271, 43,14,000 out of the Consoli-**

21 of 2003. ways) Vote on Account Act, 2003] to the sum of seventy-seven thousand two hundred seventy-one crores, forty-three lakhs and fourteen thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2003-04, in respect of the services relating to Railways specified in column 2 of the Schedule. dated Fund of India for the financial year 2003-04.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year. Appropriation
