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(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (a)

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such a person is suitable for the post, direct that the law applicable to such person and to other persons to the same and that there are other grounds for the appointment of such person from the operation of these rules.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post (s) of Middle School Teacher under Education & Human Resources Development Department (School Education), Government of Mizoram, namely:

**Short title and commencement.** (1) These Rules may be called the Human Resources Development Department (School Education) (Group 'B' post) Recruitment Rules, 2003.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**Application.** 2. The Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto annexed.

**Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.** 3. The number of the said post(s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2-4 of the First Schedule as aforesaid.

**Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.** 4. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5-14 of the First Schedule aforesaid.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

**Disqualification.** 5. No person -  
(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

School are hereby repealed. |
