#### **NOTIFICATION**

No. G. 17012/1/2000-F. Est, the 12th January, 2004. Consequent upon the creation of the Office of Chief Engineer (Civil) P.W.D. Building affected by way of re-organisation of P.W.D. and renaming of the then Chief Engineer Zone I and Chief Engineer Zone II as Chief Engineer (Civil) P.W.D., Roads and Chief Engineer (Civil) P.W.D., Highway respectively, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to order demarcation and specification of the powers, functions and responsibilities of the Engineer-in-Chief and the 3(three) Chief Engineers as follows:—

1. **Planning & Budgetting**  
Appropriation and Reap-  
propriation : The powers and planning, Budgetting appro-  
priation and reappropriation and the bud-  
getary control including administration of  
loans and advances will be vested in the  
Engineer-in-Chief.
2. **Technical Powers** : The technical powers of the Engineer-in-  
Chief, and Chief Engineers shall be as per  
provisions of the CPWD Codes. Technical  
Powers shall, however not be construed as  
Financial Powers. The latter shall be go-  
vernated by Rules and Notifications issued in  
this regards by the Government of Mizo-  
ram from time to time.
3. **Appointment and discipli-  
nary authority** : Without prejudice to the powers vested in  
this regard with the DP & AR the Engi-  
neer-in-Chief shall be appointing authority  
including promotion in respect of non-Ga-  
zatted Officers including Group-C and he  
shall exercise the powers of Disciplinary  
authority under CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965.

In case of Group-D and Work-Charge Staff appointing authority and Disciplinary authority will be the Chief Engineers within their respective jurisdictions.

Common Seniority shall be maintained for all the regular technical and work charge staff of the Department by Engineer-in-Chief. Appointments & Promotions shall be made by Engineer-in-Chief/Chief Engineer or the recommendation of DPC chaired by the Engineer-in-Chief.

4. Transfer and posting

: Without prejudice to the powers vested in this regard with the DP & AR, the Engineer-in-Chief shall exercise the power of transfer and posting of all non-Gazetted staff, inter-jurisdiction. The Chief Engineer shall have the power in respect of Group-D and Work Charge staff and transfer of posting on non-Gazetted staff within their jurisdiction.

5. Release/Control of LOC within the approved budget

: The Engineer-in-Chief shall release the budget allocation to the Chief Engineers and the Chief Engineers in turn shall issue and control LOC within their jurisdictions.

The Engineer-in-Chief shall function as Head of Department and shall have the power of supervisory control over the Chief Engineers in monitoring of works and vigilance, planning and budgetary, appropriation and re-appropriation of fund. The three Chief Engineers shall function as Heads of Department within their respective jurisdictions

The Government of Mizoram reserves the powers of review and revision of the provisions contained in this Notification from time to time.
